**RE: Beliefs, Philosophy and Ethics Enrichment visit to Krakow, Poland 13<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> March 2020**

With the new GCSE and A-Level course up and running, the BPE department has found the opportunity to take our Year 10, 12 and 13 Philosophy and Ethics students out for a weekend visit to Krakow, Poland. This is an opportunity for students to enrich their understanding of social and moral issues with an insight to key topic areas that the students have learnt about this year, such as belief in God and the Problem of Evil.

We have arranged our visit with Euro-Study Tours, with a quote for 3 nights/4 days in Krakow that includes; airport transfers, return flights from Birmingham airport, hand luggage, bed and breakfast accommodation, a visit to the Schindler Museum, a walking tour of Kazimierz – the Jewish Quarter, and a guided tour of Auschwitz-Birkenau. Students will need their own full passport (valid for 6 months from the date of departure).

The cost of this visit will be approximately £525; this includes a contingency for flight costs. Should the flights be cheaper than expected once they are booked, we will refund the difference in price.

For your child to be considered for a place on this visit, we require a deposit payment of £150 by **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019**. With the deposit payment, we will also require a photocopy of your child's passport, which will be needed to book flights.

Deposits will not be accepted after the deadline, and payments for this visit will be non-refundable once they have been sent to the travel company. The remaining balance will be due by January 2020; payments in instalments can be made through Scopay, at any time up to this date, and we will write again to inform you of the final amount once the estimated costs are confirmed.

Please also complete and return the attached parental consent form by Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019. We must receive both the deposit payment and the completed consent form by this date to reserve your child's place.

We reserve the right to exclude from this trip, at any point, any student whose behaviour gives us cause for concern. Any monies paid may be non-refundable should your child withdraw or be removed from the trip.

We will be holding a Parent Forum on **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019** in the Sixth Form Centre at 6:00pm. Please feel free to attend to discuss the itinerary and key parts of the trip.
