The week will include many important elements of Army training and the cadets will experience a wide range of activities including open range firing, adventurous training, assault courses, in the field military exercises and various specialist training events. There are always some optional extras during the camp and we will aim to provide a demanding yet interesting programme.

The total cost of the week is expected to be approximately £60.
