Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Visit to see *The Madness of George III* at Nottingham Playhouse, 20th November 2018

As you are aware the BBC came into school and filmed your child's drama lesson on 25th September. The film which focuses on former Arnold Hill student Adam Penford, Artistic Director at the Nottingham Playhouse, is scheduled to be broadcast on BBC Inside Out East Midlands on 5th November.

I am delighted that the group of pupils involved have now been invited by the Nottingham Playhouse to attend an evening performance of Adam's latest production, *The Madness of George III*, on Tuesday 20th November 2018.

For this particular performance the Nottingham Playhouse is partnering with National Theatre Live to broadcast the production live from the theatre to cinemas across the UK and beyond, and there will be cameras in the auditorium. There will be 360 degree filming which will result in audience members being filmed and appearing on screen. By attending, members of the audience are agreeing to being filmed and appearing in the broadcast.

There is no payment required for the visit, however, you will be required to drop off and collect your child from the Playhouse at the beginning and end of the performance.

The performance begins at 6.45pm, and your child will therefore be required to **meet me in the foyer for 6.15pm**. I am expecting the performance to **finish at 9.45pm** and am asking that parents are waiting in the foyer at that time to collect their child. A member of our staff will stay with our pupils until they have been collected.

School uniform is not necessary. Pupils will be responsible for any money they wish to bring to buy food or drinks during the interval.

If you would like your child to participate in this visit, could you please complete and return the attached consent form to the Trips Mailbox situated in PSU, B Block **by Monday 12th November 2018**.

We reserve the right to exclude from the trip, at any point, any pupil whose behaviour gives us cause for concern.
