What is the BTEC Driver Course?

Practical and Theoretical Driver Training

40 hours in class, 20 hours in car

BTEC Level 2 Qualification

Equivalent to a GCSE

The course is taken in addition to any A-Level or BTEC Courses
Students choose to study – not instead of



How does it work?

Five Units Overall

Four In-Class

40 hours, split into Four Units/Modules

Unit 1; Vehicle Maintenance and Construction

Unit 2; The Driving Environment

Unit 3; Ethical Vehicle Use

Unit 4; What Makes a Good Driver?



Unit 5; In Car Lessons

20 Hours In Car

Ten, two hour lessons, in pairs

Who can do the BTEC Driver Course?

Anyone who is over 16 on the 1st September 2018

You can start your practical driving lessons from 17

Only available to students at this Sixth Form

Only students who complete Year 12 at this Sixth Form can sign up



How are the in-class lessons delivered?

Lessons are after school

All in-class lessons offered to Arnold Hill Sixth Form Students have been done so on Mondays from 15:30

How long are lessons?

Lessons are a combination of 1hr and 2hr sessions

How long does the course run for?

The course starts in October and runs until early May



“Where do I sign up?”

The course costs £450

You can pay in full, or in instalments

Payment is arranged with the school

A £100 deposit is required before 24th July, with the full course fee payable by September 14th 2018

All payment for the course is to be paid to the school

If you require alternate payment arrangements, please speak to the school



“Where do I sign up?”
