As part of our commitment to give a broad student sixth form experience, we have assemblies given by outside charities and agencies.

I am pleased to inform you that on **Wednesday 1st November 2017**, all of Year 12 and Year 13 will attend a performance on **Young Driver and Passenger Safety - "Braking Point"**. The objectives listed on their website are as follows:

- Challenge perceived 'low risk' behaviour, speeding and anti-social driving
- Investigate the dangers of a passenger distracting the driver with loud music, mobile phones or 'playing' with the car's instruments
- Raise awareness of how even low levels of alcohol consumption can impair judgement
- Understand the value of using available safety measures, especially seatbelts
- How to effectively challenge irresponsible behaviour in road users, including older drivers

The material discussed in this performance will be discussed in guidance with tutors to further the message given.
