## All pupils cycling to school must now wear a helmet every day they cycle

For those whose children cycle to school, can you please ensure you and your child are aware and comply with the new requirement for <u>all</u> cyclists to wear helmets. This is for obvious safety reasons. If any child were to cycle to school without a helmet then they will be banned from bringing a bicycle to school until a helmet is used. Should a pupil again cycle to school without a helmet then their bicycle will be <u>locked</u> by the school and not released until the parent meets with a senior member of staff and agrees to purchase a helmet and ensure their child wears it. Please make sure your child is fully prepared to wear a helmet every time they bring a bicycle to school to avoid any difficulties before they happen.

### Mobile phones and audio equipment

Can you please ensure your child is made aware that they must not use their mobile phone or audio equipment at any time in the school day, <u>including</u> after their last lesson as they are leaving for the day. Mobile phones and audio equipment must not be seen or heard at any point of the school day and should not be used until pupils are <u>completely</u> off the school grounds. If a pupil were to use their mobile phone or audio equipment while still on the school grounds at the end of the day then they will be given a 30 minute detention to be served the following day. The best way to avoid a detention is to not use any equipment until they are fully off site. We appreciate your support with this.
