Re: Year 10 Bright Day visit to WorldSkills UK LIVE, Birmingham 21st November 2019

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity to attend **WorldSkills UK LIVE** (formerly The Skills Show) at The NEC Birmingham on Thursday 21st November 2019. The visit has been arranged as part of "Bright Futures", the theme for our Year 10 Bright Day. The emphasis is on preparing students for the world ahead of them, and all year 10 students are therefore invited to attend.

WorldSkills UK LIVE is the UK's largest interactive apprenticeships, skills and careers event and is designed to show students the variety of choices that are on offer to them, in education, training and employment, once they have finished their final year at school. There will be a wide range of companies and organisations at the show exhibiting the different opportunities that are available for our students. The cost of the trip is £5 which includes return travel by coach. The event begins at 9:30am and we will be leaving school at 8:00am promptly. We expect to arrive back at school for approximately 4:00pm. Lunch is not provided and students will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks for the day. If your child receives free school meals, the Academy will provide a packed lunch upon request. Alternatively, there are food stalls at the arena where students can purchase a meal. All students are expected to wear full school uniform on the day.
