Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 8 Kingswood residential visit, Peak Venture 19th – 22nd June 2020

We are very excited to announce that we are organising a residential visit to the Kingswood Centre, Peak Venture. The visit will take place from Friday 19th June to Monday 22nd June 2020. The aims of the visit are to build cooperative relationships amongst the students and develop individual confidence and self-belief, as well as offering students the opportunity to experience a variety of activities of an outdoor nature.

For parents who are new to Kingswood, they are a leading residential activity centre provider, responsible for delivering safe and rewarding activity programmes to over 130,000 children every year, and our visit is sure to provide your child with a wealth of new experiences outside of the classroom. Students benefit hugely from the experience and I feel certain that the Adventure Choice with Watersports programme which we have chosen this year, will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile. The programme combines a variety of activity sessions from aerial adventures to fun problem solving, and will encourage our students to bond and work together as a team.

Three freshly prepared, healthy, buffet style meals will be served each day, with plenty of variety on offer including hot and cold meals, a salad bar and water available at all times. Students may also bring a small amount of spending money which should not exceed £10.00.

Peak Venture has standard dormitory style accommodation. Rooms range from 4 to 12 bed dormitories, with gender-separated bathroom and shower facilities and party leader rooms close by. Sheets, duvets and pillows are provided for all guests.

The cost of the visit is **£210** which includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities.

If you would like your child to participate in this visit we require an **initial deposit of £70** via your online payment account at www.scopay.com **by Tuesday 5th November 2019**. Please do not send cash or cheques.

Before you make the payment in SCOPAY you will be asked to confirm that you give your consent for your child to participate in the visit. By ticking the box, you are making a commitment to pay for the trip in full, in line with the payment schedule, and understand that any monies paid may be non-refundable should your child withdraw or be removed from the trip.

The schedule for payments is:

1st instalment (non-refundable deposit) - £70 by 5th November 2019

2nd instalment - £70 by 31st January 2020

If a place for your child is confirmed, you will be notified in writing and asked to complete a more detailed consent form nearer the time of the visit.

If we are unable to confirm a place for your child, we will refund your deposit and offer your child a place on the reserve list.

We reserve the right to exclude from the trip, at any point, any student whose behaviour gives us cause for concern.

There will be a meeting for parents after Easter (further details to follow) which will give you the opportunity to meet the staff involved, receive information about the amenities available at the centre, what to pack, menu plans, accommodation details and a sneak peek at the types of thrilling adventures and team-building activities your child will be involved in!
