Re: Year 10 Bright Day visit to WorldSkills UK LIVE, Birmingham on 16th November 2018

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity to attend **WorldSkills UK LIVE** (formerly The Skills Show) at The NEC Birmingham on Friday 16th November 2018. This trip forms part of "Bright Futures", the theme for our Year 10 Bright Day with an emphasis on preparing pupils for the world ahead of them, and all year 10 students are therefore invited to attend.

WorldSkills UK LIVE is the UK's largest interactive apprenticeships, skills and careers event and is designed to show pupils the variety of choices that are on offer to them, in education, training and employment, once they have finished their final year at school. There will be a wide range of companies and organisations at the show exhibiting the different opportunities that are available for our pupils. The cost of the trip is £5 which includes return travel by coach. The event begins at 9:30am and we will be leaving school at 8:00am promptly. We expect to arrive back at school for approximately 4:00pm. Lunch is not provided and your child will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks for the day. If your child receives free school meals, the Academy will provide a packed lunch upon request. Alternatively, there are food stalls at the arena, where your child can purchase a meal. All pupils are expected to wear full school uniform on the day.

Please also complete the parental consent form attached by Monday 22nd October and return it to the Trips Mailbox situated in PSU, B Block to confirm your child's attendance. Pupils will not be allowed on the trip if this form is not returned.

We reserve the right to exclude from the trip, at any point, any pupil whose behaviour gives us cause for concern.
