What is a BTEC course?

- Known as BTEC National courses at Level 3 (Post 16) – run by Pearson
- Alongside A levels, BTEC Nationals are the most widely-recognised qualification for admission to Higher Education
- BTEC Nationals equip students with the specialist knowledge, practical skills and understanding they need to progress along their chosen learning and career paths.
- BTEC Nationals are career-based qualifications designed to give students the skills they need to move on to higher education or go straight into employment.
- More employers and Higher Education institutions than ever before are choosing BTEC-qualified candidates for their academic and practical knowledge and skills.



BTEC Courses we offer

BTEC Extended Certificate = 1 A Level

BTEC Diploma = 2 A Levels

BTEC Extended Diploma = 3 A Levels

- BTEC ICT (equivalent to either 1 A Level or 2 A Levels)
- BTEC Health & Social Care (equivalent to 2 A Levels)
- BTEC Business (equivalent to 1 A Level)
- BTEC Sport Science and Exercise (equivalent to either 2 A Levels or 3 A Levels in Year 13 only)
- BTEC Science (Year 13 only - equivalent to 1 A Level)



What do they include?

- These are new courses - redeveloped for teaching from September 2016 as part of 16-19 reforms
- All BTEC courses now include a least one external exam and an externally assessed assignment
- 1 re-sit opportunity for exam unit - **if fail this they do not pass the course**
- Combination of internally assessed units and externally assessed units

What are we looking for?

All applicants are required to have a Primary National Curriculum subject or one related to child development from:

- A-levels – BBB; or
- BTEC Extended Diploma – DDM; or
- 120 UCAS Tariff points from three A-levels or equivalent; and
- GCSEs – five at grade 4 or equivalent   including English, Mathematics and Science.

Applicants without A-levels will have their qualifications assessed for subject compatibility.



Final Message

- We want our students to be aspirational and aim for the higher grades
- Students to be aware of what grades they need to achieve on each unit for their overall grade - using the calculator and having discussions with teachers
- Students need to fully prepare for their external exams in January and/or Summer
- Be aware of the 1 re-sit opportunity
